

- In support to the continuing efforts of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) Health and Nutrition Unit (HNU) to intensify the preventive measures against Covid19 and to stop transmission of communicable diseases through hygiene activities, the Department of Education Central Office, with technical assistance from non-government partners, will conduct a **Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) on WASH in Schools (WinS) for BARMM** stakeholders on the following schedules:

DATE	TOPIC
September 20 – November 13, 2021	Accelerating WinS
September 20 – November 27, 2021	Leading WinS

- The above courses are deemed necessary to address the requirements to meet the minimum health standards and ensure that proper hygiene can be practiced by learners and school personnel in the current home-based learning situation amidst pandemic and in preparation for re-opening at some point in the future.
- Hence, laptops or desktop computers will be necessary for the online training. It is advised to register at <https://training.deped.gov.ph/>, follow the steps on how to enroll and check ahead of time the availability of telecommuting access and coordinate with ICT in-charge to address the need for internet connectivity.
- Attached herewith is the detailed step by step instruction on how to enroll.





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5. For September 20–November 13, 2021 course entitled **Accelerating WinS**, there will be four (4) participants from each of the 10 schools divisions in BARMM, with all identified participants to be chosen based on their roles and responsibilities in the WinS implementation. The priority participants shall be:
  - a. Member of the Division Wins TWG (priority criteria)
  - b. Division supervisor and/or health personnel tasked to manage the WinS program in the SDO and plays an important role in providing technical assistance to school on WinS implementation
6. For September 20–November 27, 2021 course entitled **Leading WinS**, there shall be two (2) participants each coming from the eighteen 18 elementary and 18 secondary schools. Selection of these elementary and secondary schools shall be based on:
  - a. The proactive roles demonstrated by the **school head**; and
  - b. One (1) **teacher** assigned as WinS focal person or school-level WinS coordinator.
