QUALITY ASSURANCE CUM TRAINING OF TRAINERS FOR THE ROLL-OUT

- 1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), in partnership with Equal Access International Philippines and Department of Education 12, will hold the Communities and Schools Leading in the Fight against Terrorism (CS-LIFT) Quality Assurance cum Toolkit Orientation for Teachers on September 21-24, 2021 at Lake Sebu, South Cotabato.
- 2. The CS-LIFT Toolkit is an education-based, behavior change approach to enhance the capacity of school-aged youth to think critically about terrorist narratives and reduce early aged recruitment and radicalization which is embedded in the Grade 10-Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Learning Area.
- 3. The CS-LIFT Quality Assurance Sessions aim to:
 - a. evaluate the CS-LIFT Toolkit under Grade 10-ESP as to content, language and
 - b. incorporate suggestions and recommendations based on the result of the evaluation: and
 - c. Finalize the CS-LIFT Toolkit for pilot-testing under MBHTE.
- 4. The CS-LIFT Toolkit Orientation for Teachers hopes for teacher-participants to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Recognize the Preventing and Countering Violent Extremism (PCVE) context in Mindanao and its effects on school children.
 - b. Discuss current concepts on peace education and identify teaching strategies which can be taught effectively.
 - c. Demonstrate the use of lesson exemplars in the CS-LIFT Toolkit.
 - d. Design implementation plans to integrate CS-LIFT Toolkit to classroom instruction.

- 5. Pilot schools must have the following minimum requirements:
 - Should be duly-recognized by the MBHTE as an operating Junior High School institution.
 - b. Can be a traditional mainstream public school or an alternative learning school.
 - c. Located in the 3 Priority Areas: Maguindanao, North Cotabato, Cotabato City.
 - d. Currently implementing Modular Home-Based Distance Learning and/or Self-learning Module (TV/Radio-Based Instruction) following the DepEd Basic Education-Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP).
 - e. Must have at least 30 enrolled students for Grade 10 level or similar equivalent level for Alternative Learning System.
 - f. Schools and teachers must have access to working internet and mobile network connection.
 - g. Preferably learners are living in tri-people communities.
- 6. Teacher-participants must have the following minimum requirements:
 - a. Teaches ESP for at least 2 years already
 - b. Basic understanding of Peace Education
 - c. Familiar with Distance Learning Approach
 - d. Will be handling an ESP subject/class for S.Y. 2021-2022
- 7. The participants must bring the following:
 - a. Laptop
 - b. E-copy of copy ESP MELC
 - c. Any e-copy of ESP materials
- 8. As such, the above-mentioned divisions are required to:
 - a. Submit two schools which will be the pilot school for this program.
 - b. Submit names of the two participating teachers per pilot school to EAIPH via email and proof of accomplished online Teacher's Profile Form (Link: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSdNoWp7GdqAXaAs unrF36cXa 9nO28P1a6hhMWrtdX8IT7WIA/viewform?usp=sf_link)
 - c. Send the selected teachers to attend the 32-hour orientation program with EAIPH at Lake Sebu, South Cotabato.
- The division office is required to submit the names of the selected teachers to talicop1987@gmail.com and furnish a copy (CC) to <u>aanay@equalaccess.org</u> on or before September 15, 2021. Selected teachers are required to accomplish the online Teacher Profile form on the same date.
- Transportation, accommodation, meals and per diem for the two-day event shall be shouldered by Equal Access International.
