1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education, through its Bureau of Alternative Learning System, joins and supports all schools divisions in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao on the opening of Alternative Learning System (ALS) classes for the School Year 2021-2022.
2. Opening of ALS classes shall focus on the significant activities starting September 13 until September 30, 2021, to wit:
  - a. Continuation of final portfolio assessment and inter-district revalida.
  - b. Accommodation of potential learners who wish to enroll in ALS sessions.
  - c. Orientation of enrolled ALS learners following the health and safety protocols.
  - d. Administration on the latest version of ALS assessment forms in accordance with the set policies and procedures: Functional Literacy Test (FLT) for A & E Elementary and Junior High School level learners, Assessment for Basic Literacy (ABL) for Basic Literacy level learners and Recognition of Prior Learning Assessment.
3. **ALS implementers shall conduct the learning delivery of ALS Life Skills Self-Directed Learning Modules 1-6 from October to November 2021.** All learning resources and forms can be accessed through this link: <https://bit.ly/MBHTEALSRepository>
4. Other ALS activities for SY 2021-2022 shall be provided in a separate issuance.
