SUBJECT : **KAMUSTAHAN SA PAARALAN (KSP): RANDOM VISITS TO SCHOOLS IN BARMM**

DATE : September 16, 2021

1. In line with the Education Continuity Plan (ECP) as stipulated in the MBHTE Memorandum No. 250, s. 2021, the Adaptive Learning Materials (ALMs) have been adopted to ensure the continuity of learning amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. These materials were purposely designed for remote learning since the pandemic has prevented the conduct of face-to-face classes.
2. Relative to this, the MBHTE, through the Curriculum and Programs Division of Basic Education, will conduct an activity dubbed as "**Kamustahan sa Paaralan (KSP): Random Visits to Schools in BARMM**". Generally, this activity seeks to check on schools on how they are doing as they open the classes for School Year 2021-2022.
3. Specifically, this activity has the following objectives:
 - a. To check on the schools' initial implementation of Adaptive Learning Materials this School Year 2021-2022.
 - b. To identify issues, concerns, and challenges concerning the Adaptive learning Materials and come up with collaborative possible solutions.
4. The activity will begin on **September 16** and will end on **September 21, 2021**. The team will not provide specific dates for schools to visit. Further, the Regional Office will conduct this activity via online to randomly selected schools from





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the Schools Division Offices in the Island Provinces. In this case, a prior notice will be given.
