This is in reference to the invitation from CHED Higher Education in the Context of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (HECBOL) Project for a **Seminar on Flexible Learning for the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education and BARMM Private Higher Education Institutions (PHEIs), Minority serving institutions (MSIs), Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs), and State universities and colleges (SUCs) on September 27-30, 2021 at Greenleaf Hotel and Resort, General Santos City.**
2. Said activity aims to provide the participants with the skills and knowledge of flexible learning, understanding its application, and concepts that should be incorporated in mainstream education.
3. Two (2) modes of participation have been devised for this activity – face-to-face and virtual.
  - **Face-to-face Participation by Selected HEIs**
    - a. All HEIs enumerated in the matrix below with corresponding allotted number of **face-to-face participants** are hereby advised to kindly send their respective participants to said activity. These are selected HEIs due to the limited number of slots. Main considerations in the selection were the proximity of the HEIs to the venue considering travel restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic (including on crossing provincial borders) and their need to further establish the flexible learning systems in their respective institutions.

- b. Registration is for free. Hotel accommodation and food during the activity dates shall also be shouldered by the HECBOL Project. However, travel and per diem expenses of participants shall be charged against your respective institutions' funds. For public HEIs please be reminded that charging of expenses shall be subject to usual government accounting and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.
- c. Each participant is required to bring his/her Medical Certificate from the local health unit or vaccination card (fully vaccinated). Health protocols shall be strictly observed during the activity (social distancing, wearing of face shield and face mask, frequent handwashing and sanitization/disinfection using alcohol). Moreover, each HEI is also expected to bring a laptop computer for use during the workshop; and
