SUBJECT : REVIEW AND ENHANCEMENT OF SECOND QUARTER ADAPTIVE
 LEARNING MATERIALS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2021-2022

DATE : October 13, 2021

1. As part of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) Education Continuity Plan (ECP), came up with the use of Adaptive Learning Materials (ALMs) since face-to-face classes is not possible. This is to ensure that relevant and responsive quality education continues amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. These ALMs are designed purposely for BARMM learners as it has been contextualized to fit their environment.
2. In this relation, the MBHTE, through the Curriculum and Instructions Division, will be conducting a **review and enhancement of Second Quarter ALMs for School Year 2021-2022**. The activity will include detailed scrutiny of all the ALMs activities, topics, objectives and their consistency to the Content and Performance Standards of Most Essential Learning Competencies. Most importantly, there is a need to ensure that these ALMs are responsive and relevant to the needs, aspiration and ideals of the Bangsamoro people as inscribed in RA 11054 or the Bangsamoro Organic Law.
3. Said activity has the following objectives:
 - a. Review the content, activities and format of Adaptive Learning Materials of the second quarter School Year 2021-2022.
 - b. Enhance the developed Adaptive Learning Materials for the Second Quarter School Year 2021-2022 following the standard set by the MBHTE-LRMDT.
4. The activity will be conducted in six (5) days and in two (2) clusters with the following schedules:
