
- 1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through the Directorate General for Higher Education in coordination with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through the Higher Education in the Context of Bangsamoro Organic Law (HECBOL) Project, will be conducting a Phase II Capacity Building Training-Seminar on Quality Assurance on October 29-31, 2021 at Greenleaf Hotel, General Santos City.
- 2. The 3-day activity aims to equip the officers, personnel and educators from the Ministry Supervised Higher Education Institutions (MSHEIs) with knowledge and technical skills on the government processes, standard and guidelines, and evaluation of different program offerings in the region.
- 3. Specifically, the activity has the following objectives:
 - a. Discuss the revise PSGs for various Baccalaureate Programs; articulate different CHED Memorandum Orders (CMOs) and its provision in relation to existing and revised programs for undergraduate and graduate.
 - b. Capacitate the participants with tools and knowledge about Quality Assurance procedures, mechanism and methods.
 - c. Design implementation mechanism about how quality assurance can be best developed and sustained at the regional level.

d. Discuss the different types and classifications of Higher education Institutions (HEIs).
