1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education through The Directorate-General for Madaris Education (MBHTE-DGME) with the support of the Australian Government in partnership with Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao will conduct a **Quarter 2 and Quarter 3 Write-shop on the Adaptive Learning Materials (ALM) for Islamic Studies and Arabic Language (ISAL) subjects from Grade 1- 3**. This is a 10 -day activity that starts on January 12, 2022 and ends on January 22, 2022, at Iligan City (Exact venue to be determined and be announced upon final booked).
2. The objectives are the following:
 - a. **Generate an enhance format and content of the Adaptive Learning Materials (ALM) that will be used by Grade 1 to Grade 3 learners in public elementary schools, integrated and traditional madaris**
 - b. **Based on the Refined Standards on Madrasah Education Curriculum (REMC), identified the most essential learning competencies that the children enrolled in Madaris will be learning using home-based learning modality across different ISAL subject areas during the pandemic.**
 - c. **Design the lessons and activities of the ISAL ALM materials for Quarter 2 and Quarter 3**





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3. Each group is expected to present daily required output at the end of the day in constructive way for improvement.
4. List of identified participants with their roles and functions are shown in **Annex A**. The participants are also required to bring their own laptop/netbook, extension wire and books as reference.
5. Meals, accommodation, pier diem and transportation of the participants will be covered by the Education Pathways to peace in Mindanao.
