In view of Chapter 1, Section 10 of the of the Bangsamoro Administrative Code, January 21 is proclaimed as the Bangsamoro Foundation Day and declared a noworking holiday in celebration of the establishment of the Bangsamoro Autonomous region in Muslim Mindanao, which shall be celebrated in recognition of the dreams and aspirations of the people to chart their social, political, cultural, and economic destiny in exercise of their right to self-determination. ONLINE QUIZTORY

Theme: "Changing people's lives, transforming the Bangsamoro: Celebrating and sustaining the gains of peace and Moral Governance."

Guidelines:

- The "Online Quiztory" is open for bonafide Junior and Senior High school students in the 11 divisions in BARMM. This activity will be participated by junior and senior high school students regardless of sex and grade level. Only two (2) students shall represent the division and shall be endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent.
- 2. The "Online Quiztory" will be held on January 19, 2022 at 10:00 o clock in the morning and link will be sent to the participants email addresses before the event to start.
- 3. Questions will focus on and but not limited to BARMM History.
- Participants are required to register their names, division, school and email to use for this activity and send to Abdulbasit L. Talicop, the Activity Coordinator, to this address mbhte.basicEdcurriculum@gmail.com and inform him through mobile number 09366262549 on or before January 18, 2022.
- On the day of the "Online Quiztory" the participants shall enter the online room 30 minutes before the schedule time wearing his/her school uniform.
- 6. Participants shall use either laptop and desktop which must be working properly. Further, participants must have their own strong internet connection and must have their camera and microphone "on" through the quiz. Note that scores are electronically tabulated and sustained strong connection is the main requirement for your scores to be counted.
- There will be three winners: first place, second place and third place.They will receive cash, medal and certificate.

Mechanics:

- The quiz master will do orientation to all participants when all are in the room.
- "The Online Quiztory" has three rounds: EASY, AVERAGE and DIFFICULT. Below are the corresponding number of items and time allotment for answering each item.

- Each participant will start with zero score at the start of the easy round.
 The accumulation of points all throughout each round will be cumulative.
- 4. At the end of the "Easy Round", the top 10 participants will proceed to the Average round. At the end of the "Average round", the top 5 participants will proceed to the "Difficult and Final round". Tabulation of scores will be given after every round.
- 5. In case of a tie, a Clincher round will be given. Once a participant answers correctly, the other participants will be automatically eliminated.
- 6. The organizer may change the rules and guidelines for this activity without prior notice **only when necessary**.
- 7. Use of calculator, electronic devices and the like during the quiz is **PROHIBITED**.
- 8. For the duration of the quiz, each participant should stay in a private room free from noise. Only the participant can stay in the room.
- Participants SHOULD ALWAYS turn on and face their cameras
 throughout the contest capturing and showing the upper half of their
 body. Thus, turning-off the microphone and camera is STRICTLY NOT
 ALLOWED.
- 10. Participants are not allowed to go outside of their private room unless the official breaks are called by the quiz master.
- 11. Non-compliance to the rules would result to automatic disqualification from the quiz.

E-POSTER MAKING CONTEST

In light of the celebration of the 3rd BARMM Foundation Anniversary, the MBHTE launches the E-Poster Making Contest.

The E-Poster Making Contest aims to engage the BARMM community in the celebration of the 3rd BARMM Foundation Anniversary with the theme "Changing people's lives, transforming the Bangsamoro: Celebrating and sustaining the gains of peace and Moral Governance".

MECHANICS / GUIDELINES:

1. **ELIGIBILITY**

- > The competition is open to all elementary and secondary level students residing within the BARMM region.
- > Standard Madrasah Curriculum (SMC) Implementers are the only private institution allowed to join the competition.
- No professional graphic designer is allowed to join.

2. ENTRIES

- There shall be three (3) entries per division and one (1) entry from the private sector. One (1) entry for elementary, one (1) entry for junior high, one (1) entry for senior high and one (1) entry for elementary from the private madaris. Three winners per categories (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place).
- Limited to 44 poster entries will be accepted.
- ➤ The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme of the 3rd BARMM Foundation Anniversary: "Changing people's lives, transforming the Bangsamoro: Celebrating and sustaining the gains of peace and Moral Governance" with an Islamic context for the senior and junior high; while entries for the elementary level's poster submission will focus on illustration of the five pillars of Islam.
- > The participants may use any coloring materials.
- ➤ The poster must be in ½ size illustration board, in a PORTRAIT format the size of the poster.
- ➤ The posters are governed by laws and regulations concerning concerning intellectual property. Thus, participants are advised to submit an original work and avoid using elements on the poser which could possibly subject it to copyright infringement.
- For verification purposes, a timelapse video recording of the participant creating the artwork/poster is also required. Non compliance may mean disqualification.
- ➤ A clear photo image of the official entry per category per division shall be submitted to the armm.hnu@deped.gov.ph with primary information about the artist such as Name, Grade Level School and Division.
- Attached requirements of poster/s with the corresponding video shall be submitted on or before January 18, 2022. File name shall be in the formal of <u>Full name</u>, <u>School</u>, and <u>Division</u>

Submission of entry constitutes permission to use contestant's name and entry for purposes of presentation, marketing and promotion without additional compensation, unless prohibited by law. All entries become property of Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE).
