In reference to the Regional Memorandum No. 1119 series of 2021 entitled Implementation of Isla Maganda Animated Cartoons and Radio-Based Series issued on September 16, 2021 by the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education, this memorandum is hereby issued for the conduct of the Launching of the Isla Maganda Project.
