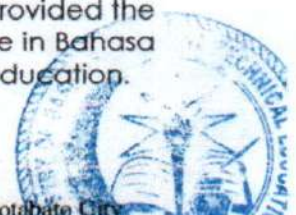

SUBJECT : **REVIEW OF ISLA MAGANDA MATERIALS AND OTHER LEARNING RESOURCES IN LOCAL LANGUAGES**

DATE : December 16, 2021

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), in partnership with Big Bad Boo Studios and with support from Australian Government thru the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao is implementing the **Isla Maganda Project** in support to ensuring K-3 children's learning continuity through different alternative learning pathways in the context of COVID-19 pandemic. The project supports the ministry's mandate on "No Bangsamoro Learner Shall Be Left Behind" and will supplement the Ministry's Adaptive Learning Modality (ALM) to strengthen early grades learners' basic foundational skills on literacy, numeracy, socio emotional, and peace education in the context of COVID19 to ensure learning continuity of Bangsamoro learners across all Schools Division Offices.
2. Isla Maganda Program aims to provide impact to 100,000 children ages 5-7 years old who are enrolled in formal and non-formal schools, and to 8,000 adults who will serve as Master Trainers to provide support to the 3,000 Teachers and 5,000 parents/guardians/para-teachers for the rollout sessions.
3. The Isla Maganda material focuses on the socio-emotional learning (SEL), peace education, literacy, and numeracy skills are available in multimedia materials such as the animated videos, radio-based materials, and books offered in 4 local languages such as Bahasa Sug, Maguindanawn, Maranaw, and Tagalog.
4. In addition, the 20-title story books are developed by the Pathways as additional supplementary materials for the K-3 learners. These big books are available in 8 local languages such as Bahasa Sug, Chavacano, Iranon, Maguindanawn, Maranaw, Sinama, Teduray, and Yakan. Moreover, Big Bad Boo also provided the 1001 Nights materials for the grades 4-6 learners that are also available in Bahasa Sug, Maguindanawn, Maranaw focusing on civic values and peace education.

5. Following the Learning Resources Development and Implementation process of the MBHTE, a material review of the Isla Maganda Series, 1001 Nights and 20-title story books will be conducted on **January 27 – 31, 2022** (excluding travel period) in **Iligan City (Cluster 1)** and in **Zamboanga City (Cluster 2)**. The final venue of the event will be communicated to the participants once confirmed.
6. A material review will be conducted with the following objectives:
 - **Orient the SDOs on the process and tool of the review of K-3 Learning Resources Development;**
 - **Review the Isla Maganda Materials, 1001 Nights and Pathways story books according to the following MBHTE parameters on:**
 - a. alignment with the curriculum;
 - b. content;
 - c. format;
 - d. presentation and organization;
 - e. accuracy and up-to-datedness of information;
 - **Ensure the materials are consistent with the targeted Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELC) intended for the learning area and grade level;**
 - **Ensure the materials are culturally appropriate, free of ideological, religious, racial, and gender biases and prejudices;**
 - **Document comments and recommendations for improvement of the materials; and**
 - **Plan ways forward for the finalization and utilization of the materials.**
7. In this respect, the participants identified in **Annex A** are enjoined to participate in this activity. Conform the order to all concerned personnel in your respective offices.
8. All expenses relative to this activity will be charged to Big Bad Boo Productions, Inc. and Pathways, subject to their regular accounting and auditing procedure.
