SUBJECT : **STRATEGIC MEETING FOR THE CONTINUING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE EDUCATION PATHWAYS TO PEACE IN MINDANAO PROGRAM**

The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) collaborates with donor agencies, international non-government organizations (INGOs), and other development partners to implement various programs aimed at improving the Bangsamoro education system and realize priorities in the Ministry's 12-point agenda.
