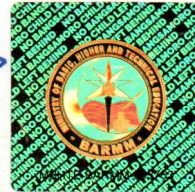

SUBJECT : **MINE ACTION FOR TRUST AND NORMALISATION IN BANGSAMORO**

DATE : October 3, 2022

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education, thru its Education Support Division's Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Section in coordination with the Swiss Foundation for Mine Action/Fondation Suisse de Deminage (FSD), shall continue safeguarding schools against Unexploded Ordnances (UXO) under its "Mine Action for Trust and Normalization in Bangsamoro (MATNIB)" and was conducted in support of and in accordance with the Comprehensive Agreement on the Bangsamoro Annex on Normalization (commitment to clearing UXO and landmines, signed between the GPH and MILF in 2014).
2. Anent to this, all schools division superintendents shall provide coordination and support to Explosive Ordnance Risk Education (EORE) activities thru their Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordinators, as well as School Heads thru their School Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordinators to ensure quality implementation, monitoring, and evaluation.
3. All Traditional Madrasah Institutions may coordinate with FSD for Explosive Ordnance Risk Education (EORE).
