SUBJECT : **PROVINCIAL FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSIONS FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE DIRECTORATE GENERAL FOR MADARIS EDUCATION STRATEGIC PLAN**

DATE : October 4, 2022

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through its Directorate General for Madaris Education (DGME) with the support from the Australian Government through the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao, will be conducting a **Provincial Focus Group Discussions (FGD) for the Formulation of the DGME Strategic Plan** – a consultation/dialogue to identify the gains as well as the challenges and bottlenecks that beset the growth and development of the Madaris education.
2. The objective of the activity is to ensure that there is greater buy-in from stakeholders of DGME, who played a larger role throughout the decision-making process.
3. Specifically, the FGD seeks to:
  - a. level-off expectations among the key stakeholders in the island provinces about the DGME;
  - b. determine the baseline resources and competencies of Madaris in each province;
  - c. identify the strengths of the Madaris Education in each province which can be highlighted in the strategies;
  - d. determine the weaknesses/areas of Madaris Education in respective provinces that are needed for the improvement of the DGME;
  - e. discuss key priorities in each provincial Madaris; and
  - f. generate recommendations from various stakeholders on how the policies, programs, and services can be effectively and efficiently implemented and monitored.
