This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 452, s. 1994, which institutionalized the Second Week of October of every year as National Mental Health Week.
- This year's celebration carries the theme "Mental Health and Wellbeing for All: Promoting Mental Health in Physical and Virtual Spaces."
