 Republic Act No. 11037 or also known as the "Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act" institutionalized the national feeding program for undernourished children to combat hunger and undernutrition among Filipino children. The program includes the provision of at least one fortified meal for a period of not less than 120 feeding days in a year.

- 2. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through its Health and Nutrition Unit (HNU), is consistent in its commitment to providing good nutrition and proper nourishment to all learners in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao and shall begin the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022.
- 3. Each learner will receive six (6) kilos of Iron Fortified Rice, three (3) kilos of Mungbeans, and one (1) kilo of Anchovy per tranche that will be delivered directly to target schools and/or identified division drop-off points but with transportation assistance provided by the supplier. There will be three (3) tranches for the delivery of commodities. The following are the activities for the implementation of the SBFP FY 2022:
  - a. There will be an orientation on the Operational Guidelines of the SBFP 2022 to the school heads of target school beneficiaries for each division.
  - Launching of the SBFP FY 2022 is scheduled on October 14, 2022, at Lanao del Sur Il Division.
  - c. Regional inspection team shall conduct an inspection prior to the delivery in every division for actual spot checking of commodities.
  - d. Delivery team will facilitate the distribution of the SBFP commodities at the target schools and/or identified division drop-off points.
