1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1906, s. 2009 entitled **Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as National Indigenous Peoples Month**, the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) enjoins all its offices and schools to observe the national celebration through various commemorative and advocacy activities.
2. As the primary government agency mandated to protect and promote the rights of every Filipino learner to basic education, including the inculcation of values that promote recognition of the nation's cultural diversity, the MBHTE, through the Bureau of Indigenous Peoples Education (BIPEd), intends to substantially contribute to the objectives of the said observances through its extensive network of schools, field offices, and various learning programs
3. For this year's observance of the National IP Month, the MBHTE shall be guided by the theme: **Kasaysayan, Karunungan at Wika ng mga Katutubong Pamayanan: Mga Saligan ng Katutubong Pagkakakilanlan at Tulay Tungo sa Inklusibong Kaunlaran**. The theme highlights the need to deepen the understanding of the specific role of each and everyone who has a stake in IPEd in protecting and nurturing the initial gains of the program.
4. In line with this, the Regional Office and the schools division offices are enjoined to support the month-long celebration by undertaking appropriate and relevant activities during the week of **October 1 to 31, 2022** through, but not limited to, the following:
  - a. conduct appropriate learning activities which promote the objectives and message of the celebration (e.g., activities that promote awareness of and respect for indigenous cultural communities, particularly those within or





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- proximal to the school vicinity subject to the guidelines of the IATF in the observance of the COVID-19 pandemic)
- b. conduct advocacy activities for teaching and non-teaching personnel, and other stakeholders
  - c. hanging streamers/banners in strategic places in the vicinity of the MBHTE offices and schools (an electronic file of the standard layout shall be provided to regional offices by the DepEd-Indigenous Peoples Education Office/IPsEO)
  - d. IP Month 2022 materials:
    - i. **Poster/Tarpaulin Design for Central Office without field logo placement**  
While this is for CO use, you may opt to use this if you don't need to insert your respective logos in the poster or tarpaulin.
    - ii. **Poster/Tarpaulin Design for Field WITH logo placement**  
JPEG and Photoshop (PSD) Editable files are included for 7x7 and 7x3 poster sizes so that Logos can be adjusted based on the discretion of field offices.
    - iii. **Facebook Frame**  
Format of the Profile Photo Frame that can be used on any social media platform. The guide on how to download and use the frame is included in the folder.

## BUREAU OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION (BIPEd) LOGO MAKING CONTEST

### Mechanics, Rules, and Regulation

#### PURPOSE

The Bureau of Indigenous Peoples Education (BIPEd) is challenging/calling the students at all grade levels in the entire BARMM to create a LOGO for the Bureau of Indigenous Peoples Education (BIPEd) that will be used for official transactions in various ways including communication, social media, printed materials, clothing, etc.

#### GUIDELINES

1. Logo must include words "BUREAU OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION" AND "BIPEd"
2. Logo must be the original masterpiece of the participant
3. Logo may include any colors
4. Logo may either be computer generated, or created with pencils, crayons, markers, or paint
5. Logo must be simple, not overly detailed and all elements must be discernible when reproduce in small sizes.
6. Each participant provides a concise rationale of the details of their entry
7. The logo design must align with flagship "**BATANG KATUTUBO NG BARMM, DI BIBITW, IPEdukado**"
8. Winner is obliged to give his/her style guide

#### PARTICIPANTS

The competition is participated by all Divisions in BARMM region including private schools

#### SUBMISSION

1. Designs maybe submitted in electronic or paper formats
2. Images must be a minimum of 3 inches by 3 inches (3"x3")
3. Electronic submissions should be in jpg or tiff file formats
4. Entries made in-person or received by mail can be scanned into an electronic format in the office of the bureau.

#### SUBMISSION DEADLINE

October 20, 2022, 12:00 noon, mailed entries must be postmarked by October 19, 2022, 12:00 noon.

## JUDGING

A committee comprised of the Office of the Basic Education Director General, Bureau Directors, Pathways, and TTG will judge and select the winning entry. All entries will be judged on their visual appeal, adherence to the concept prompting the contest, quality of design, and ease of reproduction for the purposes stated above. The judge's decision is final. Be guided by the following overall criteria:

**Concept/relevance-----40**

**Authenticity/uniqueness-----30**

**Creativity/impact-----30**

## COPYRIGHT

Winning artist shall sign an intellectual property release for the intent that the BIPED shall fully own the rights of the logo. The bureau has also an exclusive right to the winning logo design, publish it on its webpage, and in other media and corporate materials such as letterheads and envelopes. The bureau reserves its rights to further improve or refine alteration on the final artwork of the winning entry. The winning artist will disclaim any trademarks and without limitation, all other rights related to the design. Any complains that may arise due to the authenticity of the entry is the participants responsibility to prove to the contest body.

## PRIZE

The ultimate winner shall receive cash prizes plus a medal, certificate, and a jacket with the winning logo in front and a logo of MBHTE *with a statement "BATANG KATUTUBO NG BARMM, Di Bibitiw, IPEdukado"* embroidered at the back. The coach shall also receive cash prizes, certificate, and a jacket. A consolation prizes shall also be given to all participants. Ultimate winner will be notified through phone call or email by the bureau. Awarding ceremony will be on the IP month culmination activity in their respective division.
