- 1. Pursuant to Section 36 of Republic Act No. 9710, otherwise known as the Magna Carta of Women (MCW), all government departments, including their attached agencies, offices, bureaus, state universities and colleges, government-owned and controlled corporations, local government units and all other government instrumentalities shall adopt gender mainstreaming as a strategy to promote women's human rights and eliminate gender discrimination in their systems, structures, policies, programs, processes, and procedures; Section 37-C of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the MCW provides that all concerned government agencies and instrumentalities mentioned above shall establish or strengthen their GAD Focal Point System (GFPS) or a similar GAD mechanism to catalyze and accelerate gender mainstreaming within the agency.
- 2. In line with this, the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education, through the Directorate General for Madaris Education, will be conducting an Orientation on the Establishment of the GAD Focal Point System on October 24, 2022, at Em-Manor Hotel and Convention, Cotabato City.
- 3. The activity aims to:
  - a. promote awareness and appreciation of GAD and generate support from toplevel management;
  - b. establish, institutionalize, and strengthen the GFPS of MBHTE-DGME;
  - c. orient the DGME employees on the composition, functions, and responsibilities of the GFPS; and
  - d. ensure the gender-responsiveness of Madrasah education programs.
- 4. Training expenses shall be charged to the 5% GAD fund subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
