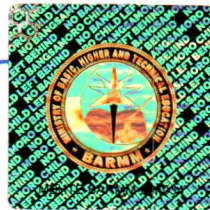

SUBJECT : TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) FOR MUDARRIS OF MADARIS EDUCATION

DATE : OCTOBER 18, 2022

Section 18 of Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise known as the "Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao" provides that:

**Section 18. Madaris Educational System, Islamic and Arabic Studies.** – In coordination with the Department of Education, Commission on Higher Education, and the Technical Education and Skills and Development Authority, The Bangsamoro Government shall establish, maintain, and supervise Madaris education in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. In the case of Madaris teachers, the Civil Service Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations to set the standards for their qualifications, appointments, and promotions.

Moreover, the Bangsamoro Autonomous Act No. 18, otherwise known as the Bangsamoro Education Code of 2021, vests upon the Minister of MBHTE the authority to grant special eligibility for *Mudarris*.

In order to institutionalize the above-cited provisions of laws, and as discussed also during the dialogue with Civil Service Commission (CSC) for BARMM, there is a need to come up with a Technical Working Group (TWG) for *Mudarris*, with the following composition, to wit:

The functions of the TWG are listed hereunder, to wit:

1. Formulate the qualification standard for the position of Mudarris in accordance with applicable laws and pertinent CSC rules and regulations;
2. Formulate the requirements and guidelines for the grant of Special Eligibility under Section 105 of Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 18 of 2021, otherwise known as the Bangsamoro Education Code (BEC);
3. Facilitate the meeting with the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and other stakeholders;
4. Submit recommendation to effectively ensure the institutionalization of the position for Muddaris and the grant of the subject Special Eligibility; and
5. Such other functions as may directed by the Minister.

After receipt of this Memorandum Order, the member of this TWG shall immediately convene and exercise the function of their office.

The creation of the TWG, however, does not entail additional allowance, compensation or salary other those allowed by law, budgeting and accounting rules and regulations.
