Subject : **GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MBHTE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BASIC EDUCATION PUBLIC SCHOOLS, MINISTRY SUPERVISED HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, AND ONE-TIME SCHOLARSHIP FOR LEARNERS IN ACCREDITED MADRASAH WITHIN BARMM**

Date : August 15, 2022

I. RATIONALE

The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education maintains its commitment in providing for the establishment, maintenance, and support for integrated education system responsive to the needs and aspirations of the Bangsamoro People.

This school year has been challenged with different circumstances. With the opening of face-to-face classes, after 2 years of closure, it is apparent that public educational institutions require preservation beyond customary. Currently, the Bangsamoro Communities are struggling on the economic effects brought by Covid-19 Pandemic, rising inflation rate and transportation cost due to high fuel prices, and natural calamities currently devastating their livelihood.

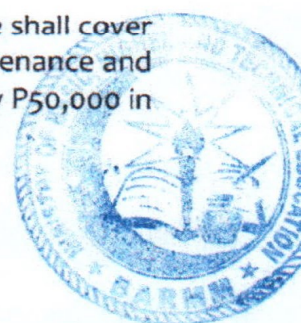
In view hereof, the Ministry has crafted these guidelines in the distribution of various Financial Assistance to Learners, Schools, and Public Institutions in Higher Education under the jurisdiction and supervision of the Ministry and those that are deemed integral components of the BARMM educational system.

II. OBJECTIVE

These guidelines are issued by the Ministry to provide a system of selection, implementation, and distribution of various Financial Assistance to beneficiaries thru an effective and efficient method.

III. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- A. Financial Assistance for Public Schools in Basic Education – This assistance shall cover costs for Repairs and Maintenance of Public-School Facilities under Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) Allotment Class with unit prices below P50,000 in accordance with COA Circular 004-2022 dated May 31, 2022.

- B. Financial Assistance for MBHTE Supervised Higher Education Institutions (MSHEI's) – This assistance shall cover the costs for Repairs and Maintenance of School Facilities of MBHTE Supervised Higher Education Institutions under Capital Outlay (CO) Allotment Class.
- C. One-Time Scholarship for Madaris Learners – Form of assistance or support given in cash to learners-in-crisis in relation to the ranking system as herein provided in any grade level and currently enrolled in accredited madrasah.

IV. BENEFICIARIES

- A. Directorate General for Higher Education
 - A.1 *School-Beneficiaries*
 - a) MBHTE Supervised Higher Education Institutions
- B. Directorate General for Madaris Education
 - B.1 *Learner-Beneficiaries*
 - a) Learners of MBHTE-Accredited Madrasah at any grade level
- C. Directorate General for Basic Education
 - C-1 *School-Beneficiaries*
 - a) Public Schools at all levels (K to 12) in Basic Education under the Ministry

V. RANKING SYSTEM

- A. *School-Beneficiaries*
 - a) The Office of the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) shall prepare the Matrix (Annex B) based on the Selection Criteria as provided in Annex A hereof.

All Supervisors are mandated to conduct school-to-school inspection as basis for the preparation of the Matrix (Annex B). Fund for Supervision Expenses shall be downloaded to the respective Schools Division Offices (SDO).

All MBHTE Supervised Higher Education Institutions within BARMM are recipient, thus, are exempted from the preparation of the Matrix (Annex B). However, the Office of the Bangsamoro Director-General (BDG) shall coordinate with beneficiaries and prepare all necessary information for the transfer of Financial Assistance to appropriate accounts.

b) Only basic education public schools ranked within the Top 75 highest scores shall be submitted to the Office of the BDG for Basic Education for Final Review and Consolidation. In case of a tie, priority shall be given to the older established school. Deadline for submission by SDS/OIC-SDS to BDG for Basic Education will be on or before October 28, 2022.

c) All submitted matrix shall remain recommendatory. Schools not included in the Top 75 are not precluded to form part of School-Beneficiaries. Notwithstanding, all school-beneficiaries of Financial Assistance for Public Schools in Basic Education are subject to final review and approval of the Office of the Minister.

B. Learner-Beneficiaries

a) School Heads of MBHTE-Accredited Madrasah shall prepare the Matrix (Annex C) based on the Selection Criteria as provided in Annex A of this Memorandum. Please coordinate with the Office of BDG for Madaris Education for proper submission and compliance.

b) School Heads shall limit the selection process to duly identified learners-in-crisis situation. Only those learners with highest scores within the Top 200 shall be submitted to Office of the BDG for Madaris Education for final review and consolidation. In case of a tie, priority shall be given to the older learner.

All relatives within the 3rd degree of affinity or consanguinity (son or daughter, son-in-law or daughter-in-law, nephew or niece, granddaughter or grandson, etc.) of any permanent employee in the school shall automatically be disqualified. Deadline for submission by School Heads to BDG for Madaris Education will be on or before October 28, 2022.

c) All submitted matrix shall remain recommendatory. Learners not included in the Top 200 are not precluded to form part of Learner-Beneficiaries. Notwithstanding, all learner-beneficiaries of One-Time Scholarship for Madaris Learners are subject to final review and approval of the Office of the Minister.

VI. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

All parties shall fully comply with existing laws, rules and regulations consistent with their respective mandate and administrative policies and guidelines.

A. The MBHTE-BARMM shall:

1. Provide funding support for the realization of the agreements stipulated herein, subject to the availability of funds and in compliance with government accounting rules and regulations;
2. Ensure timely release of funds to give sufficient time to implement the intended purpose of the funds from the date of the effectivity of this Agreement;
3. Transfer the necessary funds by issuing funding check/s to be deposited to Local Currency Bank Account with any Authorized Government Depository Bank of the Second Party

B. The School-Beneficiaries shall:

1. Receive and manage the funds allotted for the purpose for which it is intended and in compliance with the government accounting rules and regulations and this Memorandum Order;
2. Submit to the MBHTE-BARMM periodic physical and financial status reports on the implementation of the program i.e., liquidation documents such as statement of work accomplished, breakdown of expenditures, photos and other documents exhibiting the progress of implementation;
3. Acknowledge to abide with and to be bound by the Guidelines for the Implementation of MBHTE Financial Assistance to Basic Education Public Schools, State Universities and Colleges and Learners in Accredited Madrasah Within BARMM issued by the MBHTE-BARMM, which is made an integral part of this Agreement;
4. Ensure that all disbursements shall be in compliance to the law on procurement (R.A. 9184) and to the existing GPPB resolutions;
5. Ensure proper and timely liquidation of all the funds downloaded to the institution. Liquidations reports which shall include the Report of Checks Issued and Report of Disbursements duly received by the auditor, and any relevant documents required by COA.

VII. SUBMISSION

A. When to Submit

Deadline for submission, by Office of the BDG for Basic and Madaris Education, of **Consolidated Matrix of Top 75 School-Beneficiaries** and **Top 200 Learner-Beneficiaries** will be on or before **November 4, 2022**.
