# **RULES AND MECHANICS**

# SCHOOL VACCINATION CONTEST

## INTRODUCTION

The school opening in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) last 22 August 2022 emphasizes the importance of readiness and safety of the schools in the region to ensure that school personnel, teachers, parents, guardians, and most especially the learners, are in a conducive and safe learning environment. It is undeniable that the Philippines, including the BARMM, is still under the COVID-19 pandemic with different and new variants of the virus seriously threatening our school personnel especially the learners. To date, there is still no definitive treatment for COVID-19; and, more people, including children, are still infected by the virus, causing mild to critical symptoms and even death. The development of vaccines and getting vaccinated against COVID-19 is still the best solution to greatly mitigate and prevent the spread of the virus in the schools along with the already existing health and safety measures and practices in place, to keep the school personnel and learners safe while at school.

However, since the rollout of COVID-19 vaccination in BARMM last February 2021, there is still a significant number of school personnel and learners who remain unvaccinated. Despite the various initiatives (i.e., School-Based Immunization Program and Special Vaccination Days) in collaboration with the LGUs and the Ministry of Health, the number of unvaccinated personnel and learners are still high.

In this regard, the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) will initiate a school vaccination contest and provide awards to those who have achieved 100% (or the highest) vaccination coverage in their respective schools following the set criteria by our Health and Nutrition Unit (HNU). Furthermore, the schools will have an opportunity to share their best practices and stories in their journey during the vaccination campaign and be rewarded for the meritorious efforts. Therefore, the ministry invites all the schools to join and have all the learners and school personnel vaccinated in BARMM to reach herd immunity and be protected against COVID-19.

# **GET VAXXED TO WIN CONTEST**

#### **Contest Period**

- The contest will start on 27 October 2022 and ends on 18 November 2022 (Friday) at 5:00PM.
- Vaccination and entries that are submitted before or after the contest period will be disqualified. Submissions (including screenshots of reports/vaccination coverage) will be accepted for the duration of the contest using any of the following methods: Facebook messenger, SMS, email.
- 3. All entries should be submitted on or before 18 November 2022 at 5:00PM.

# **Eligibility and Qualifications**

1. The contest is open to all public and registered private schools, including accredited Madaris institutions in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.

- 2. To qualify, schools should have at least 85% COVID-19 vaccination coverage for learners<sup>1</sup> and school personnel<sup>2</sup>. Schools with less than 85% COVID-19 vaccination coverage will not be eligible to join the contest.
- 3. to November 18, 2022:
  - a. For 5-17 years old completed primary doses.
  - b. Teachers and non-teaching personnel completed first booster.

# How to Join

- 1. Eligible schools are only allowed to submit one entry based on the categories described in Contest Mechanics (a) and is considered final.
- 2. Entry should be on the basis of actual school category as described in Contest Mechanics (a).
- 3. Participating schools shall submit their Entry Form 1 and MOVs to the Division NIC.

# Validation and Means of Verification

- 1. Entries submitted will be checked and validated by the Ministry of Health (MOH) for the correctness of data and vaccination coverage.

  - a. Compilation of vaccination cards of learners and school personnel (scanned and photocopy)

- b. List of learners with LRN and school personnel vaccinated
- c. RHU Certification on the veracity of information (original copy)
- d. Barangay Certification on the veracity of information (original copy)

## **Selection of Winners**

- 1. One (1) winner for each category which will be selected for cities (9 winners) and non-cities (9 winners), and a special award for the division with the highest vaccination coverage (1 winner), with a total of 18 winners.
- 2. Winners will be determined based on percentage accomplishment from February 1, 2022, to November 18, 2022.
- 3. In case of a tie in the vaccination percentage among schools, the number of learners and teachers vaccinated is considered e.g. if both schools A and B reached 100% the number of learners and teachers vaccinated are counted. The school with the highest percentage coverage improvement wins
- 4. Announcement of winners will be made one week before the Education Summit in Davao City on 5-6 December 2022. Awarding of winners will be on 7 December 2022.

Title - Font size: 16; Body - Font size: 12.

Line spacing: 1.5, Margin: 1 inch

- 3. Entries must be accompanied by 3 photos with captions (and crediting the photographer) that are relevant to the story.
- 4. Photos must be in .JPG or .PNG format. Photos should be submitted individually, not in collage. Photos should not be edited or manipulated. Photos can be submitted separately for the best photo category.

#### **Photo**

- 1. Photos submitted must be in .PNG format. Photos should be submitted individually, not in collage. Photos should not be edited or manipulated. Photos can be submitted separately for the best photo category.
- 2. Photos submitted must include a caption and crediting the photographer.

#### Video

- 1. The video format submission is only open for Junior High School and Senior High School both for students and school personnel.
- 2. The video submission must not exceed 2 mins.
- 3. Videos must be in mp4 format.
