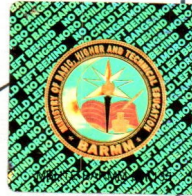

SUBJECT : **CONTENT DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP ON MBHTE'S IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR K-3 TEACHERS IN THE BANGSAMORO**

DATE : October 26, 2022

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) pursued the development of the Bangsamoro Teachers' Professional and Moral Development Standards (BPTMD) as an initial step toward improving teaching quality. The BPTMD standards are contextualized versions of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) that considered the need to "institutionalize an education framework that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people".
2. An Inception Planning Workshop for the In-service Training Program was conducted last October 12-14, 2022 in Cotabato City which generated the following outputs:
 - a. Finalized structure at the regional and division level that will lead the implementation of the program.
 - b. Developed division-level implementation and operational plans for the training rollout and delivery, including its technical and operational requirements.
 - c. Prepared the initial draft of the monitoring and evaluation plan.
3. Following the agreed next steps and ways forward for the In-service training program, the ministry's Basic Education sub-sector, in collaboration with the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao (Pathways) Program, will organize a **Content Development Workshop on MBHTE's In-service Training Program for K-3 Teachers in the Bangsamoro** on November 2-6, 2022 in Davao City (specific venue will be finalized and communicated directly to the participants).
4. This workshop has the following objectives:
 - a. Map out, prioritize, and unpack the key K-3 teacher competencies in alignment with BPTMD and PPST standards.





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- b. Develop the K-3 training course outline and designs anchored on the priority domains and indicators.
 - c. Prepare the trainers' and teachers' training course guides and modules.
 - d. Create the pre and post-K-3 teacher training assessment tools.
5. Traveling expenses and per diem of the participants from the SDOs and the management team from the MBHTE-Central Office to and from the venue, food, and accommodation shall be charged to Pathways funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Keep the necessary documents for reimbursement purposes.
