- Pursuing targets in the General Appropriations Act in the Bangsamoro (GAAB), the 6
 Ministry-supervised Higher Education Institutions (MSHEIs) and the REMACADEMY have
 been undergoing a process of strategic planning for 2023-2025. Writeshop 1 was
 conducted last July 28-30, 2021 at EM Manor Hotel, Cotabato City, and Writeshop 2 was
 held last November 4-6, 2021 at Al Nor Hotel and Convention Center, Cotabato City.
- The Writeshop 3 will be the first regional activity to be participated by the HEIs. Planning coaches have already been onboarded by the MBHTE through its partner agency Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao (Pathways) and the Orient Integrated Development Consultants, Inc. (OIDCI).
- The activity shall be participated by the seven (7) HEIs directly-supervised and managed by the MBHTE:

A. 6 MSHEIS

Balabagan Trade School (BTS)

Hadji Butu School of Arts and Trades (HBSAT)

iii. Lanao Agricultural College (LAC)

iv. Lapak Agricultural School (LAS)

- 4. Writeshop 3 is the third of a series of four regional activities lined up by this Ministry relative to the crafting of the strategic plans. Purposely, it is for the HEI Working Group and its respective planning coach to enhance, finalize, and submit their respective HEIs strategic plan after undergoing:
 - A. The remaining strategic planning steps:

Step 5: Formulating/Enhancing MSHEIS Goals and Objectives

Step 6: Identifying & Prioritizing Programs & Projects

Step 7: Determining Legislative and Policy Requirements; Communicating the Plan; and Monitoring and Evaluation;

- B. Consolidation, harmonization, and alignment with the indicative Bangsamoro Education Reform and Development Plan (BERDP) 20021-2035, BARMM's Enhanced 12-Point Priority Agenda, and the ongoing formulation of the 2nd Bangsamoro Development Plan (BDP) (at least process wise); and
- C. Integration of the following:

c.1 Learning Futures;

c.2 Gender Equality, Disability, and Social Inclusion (GEDSI) framework;

- c.3 Moral governance and mainstreaming of Islamic values in the curriculum (particularly the embedment of Islamic values in all levels of the education sector from primary, and secondary to higher education levels)
- c.4 Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBME);

c.5 One MBHTE Strategy; and

- c.6 Partnership with local government unit (LGU).
- The activity also aims to discuss ways forward to plan approval packaging and publication, and dissemination.
- Simultaneously and separately, a review of the draft strategic plan of the Directorate General of Madaris Education (DGME) shall also be conducted by Pathways-OIDCI among DGME participants within this writeshop.
- 7. Considering the foregoing, the Ministry-Supervised Higher Education Institutions (MSHEIs) Strategic Plan 2023-2025 (Writeshop 3) will be conducted on October 16-19, 2022 at The Pinnacle Hotel and Suites, Sta. Ana, Davao City with October 16, 2022 as arrival, October 17-18, 2022 as activity proper dates, and October 19, 2022 as departure. (List of participants and indicative programme are attached.)
