- Strengthening teaching quality is part of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) priority agenda for education reform in the Bangsamoro region. The MBHTE has made significant investments to improve the capacities of our Kindergarten to Grade 12 teachers in Bangsamoro through the In-Service Training Program. To pursue this, we have outlined several activities that are planned to be implemented until the end of this year, 2022.
- Part of it is the content development of the following outputs, targeted to be completed by November 23, 2022: Training modules for the Training of K-3 Trainers; Grade-level specific training modules for Kindergarten to Grades 3 Teachers; Pre and Post Assessment Tool for K-3 Teachers; Monitoring and Quality Assurance Tool for the TOT and training implementation roll out.
- 3. With this, a Content Development Review and Validation Workshop on MBHTE's Inservice Training Program for K-3 Teachers in the Bangsamoro will be conducted on November 24-28, 2022 (inclusive of travel dates) in Manila (specific venue is yet to be fixed). The activity is in collaboration with the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao (Pathways) Program.
