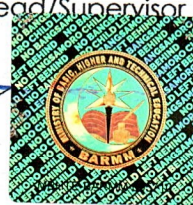

SUBJECT : **PILOTING OF POLICY GUIDELINES ON GRANTING GOVERNMENT
 RECOGNITION OF FORMAL AND NON-FORMAL MADARIS**

DATE : February 13, 2023

1. This has reference to the issued MBHTE Regional Memorandum No. 041, s. 2023 dated January 23, 2023, re **Finalization of Policy Guidelines and Implementing Rules in Granting Government Recognition to Formal and Non-Formal Madrasah Education**. The Ministry's Directorate General for Madaris Education (DGME), in partnership with the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao, will conduct the **Piloting of Policy Guidelines on Granting Government Recognition to Formal and Non-Formal Madaris** on **February 16-20, 2023** at **Tawi-Tawi Division**.
2. The said policy guidelines are the consolidated output of the previously conducted workshops of the DGME and its stakeholders. As such, this will be used by the DGME in the validation and monitoring of the private Madaris for their application, renewal of a permit to operate, and government financial assistance. Also, said guidelines will cover the process of application to Permit-to-Operate and recognition among the non-formal Madaris.
3. Specifically, the activity aims to:
 - a. determine the issues and concerns related to the compliance of the Madaris applicants to the set requirements;
 - b. test the applicability of the crafted policy guidelines and its implementation; and
 - c. agree on the plans for ways forward.

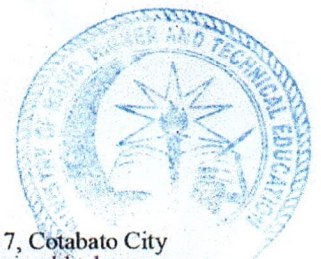


SUBJECT : **FINALIZATION OF POLICY GUIDELINES AND IMPLEMENTING RULES IN GRANTING GOVERNMENT RECOGNITION TO FORMAL AND NON-FORMAL MADRASAH EDUCATION**

DATE : January 23, 2023

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through the Directorate General for Madaris Education (DGME) with support from the Australian Government through the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao, will be conducting the **Finalization of Policy Guidelines and Implementing Rules in Granting Government Recognition of Formal and Non-Formal Madrasah Education** on **January 27-28, 2023** at Dusit Thani, Davao City.
2. These policy guidelines are limited to the Private Madrasah both Formal and Non-Formal Madrasah such as Traditional Madrasah (which requires attendance during weekends, Chapter 1, Section 49 of BEC) and Markaz Tahfidz Al- Qur'an within the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao. This policy shall also serve as a guide for the provision of other support services following the requirements of the Guidelines on the Support to Madaris Education.
3. Specifically, the activity seeks to:
 - a. Discussed and consolidated the results of three consultations with the 134 Private Madaris, Legal Office, and education experts;
 - b. Finalized the guidelines for Madrasah Accreditations and Establishment.
 - c. Agreed plan for the trial of the guidelines.
 - d. Establish coordination with Directorate General for Basic Education
