IN 15 SITES OF OPPORTUNITY 2.0 PROGRAM

**DATE :** December 19, 2022

The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in partnership with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) Opportunity 2.0 (O2) Program and Education Development Center (EDC), and implemented by the Southeast Asian Minister of Education Organization Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO-INNOTECH) will conduct a Mid-Program Alternative Learning System (ALS) 2.0 Learning Summit from **January 18 to 20, 2023, Tagaytay City** (details on the specific venue will be communicated in a separate memorandum).

The said activity aims to:

1. Gather key ALS implementers from the 15 O2 sites;
2. Share and learn from the good practices in the implementation of the ALS O2 Program;
3. Identify the next steps to sustain the gains achieved from the O2 Program; and
4. Strengthen the capacity and collaboration among ALS implementers in the O2 sites.

In this connection, the DepEd personnel listed in **Attachment No. 1** are requested to attend the said activity. Each identified Schools Division Office (SDO) is requested to present good practices and innovations that successfully addressed challenges faced based on the following themes:

1. Community mapping/stakeholder engagements;
2. Conduct of pre-program assessment and enrollment;

3. Implementation of the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC);
4. Adoption of community-based teaching and learning strategies;
5. Management of learners with unique circumstances, i.e. in special cases, working students etc.;
6. Development of learning materials across the learning levels;
7. Development and assessment of presentation portfolio;
8. Preparation for the Accreditation and Equivalency test (A&E);
9. Support to learners in difficult situations i.e. GIDA, financial, psychological etc.;
10. Support to teachers related to portfolio development, project-based learning, research, or material development, curriculum implementation or integration; and
11. Other ALS good practices not specified in the list.

The initiative(s) to be showcased by the SDO must be implemented by the ALS teacher/specialist/supervisor in the Community Learning Centers (CLCs)/schools or across several CLCs/schools for the past two (2) years. As evidence, the Division Team must display any of the following:

1. Documentation of the detailed processes used;
2. Manipulatives/demonstration materials used by teachers; and
3. Students' outputs, posters, and video materials/ resources.

The official delegation will be provided with **free** hotel accommodation, meals, and insurance coverage. Tickets for air travel arrangements will be facilitated by SEAMEO INNOTECH while the cost of land travel will be reimbursed based on EDC-approved rates with corresponding receipts and supporting documents.
