- 1. The Responsive Innovation Fund (RIF) is a grant facility of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) through the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao (Pathways) Program. It provides opportunities for stakeholders to support the delivery of quality education services as well as contribute to peacebuilding in the ARMM.
- 2. To this date, it has awarded Twelve (12) RIF Grants to several Non-Government Organizations and Civil Society Organizations in BARMM that needs to be monitored and evaluated jointly with the MEARL Team of Pathways and M&E Officer of the Basic Education Directorate.
- 3. Previously, a monitoring of the ongoing RIF projects in the Provinces of Tawi-Tawi and Basilan have been conducted from September 19-30, 2022. Part of the agreement in the previous monitoring is to conduct another round of monitoring to check the compliance of the partner organization on the technical notes and observations of the monitoring team of Pathways and MBHTE-Basic Education;
- 4. Thus, another round of Monitoring will be conducted from **February 6-11, 2023** in the Province of Tawi-Tawi and Basilan.
- 5. The purposes of this activity are the following:
 - a. To inspect the compliance by Tarbilang Foundation, Inc. (TFI) in the Municipality of Sitangkai, Tawi-Tawi to the approved project amendments relating to replacement of project sites.
 - b. To discuss with RIF partners Tawi Tawi Life Foundation (TFLF), TFI in Tawi Tawi, and Basilan Women Initiative Foundation, Inc. (BWIF) in Lamitan City, Basilan their sustainability plans post project completion in March 2023.
 - c. To discuss with Tau-SPARTAN of Tawi-Tawi the next steps in project development (grant agreement, start and end dates, inception, and training). The proposal of Tau-SPARTAN is among the three (3) groups that DFAT recently approved on Friday last week.
 - d. To provide technical assistance.
