 - a. increase oral health literacy among the public; and
 - b. recognize WOHD campaigns to unite and help reduce the burden of oral diseases, which affect individuals, health systems, and economies everywhere.
- Online activities in the school level such as Oral Health Story Telling and Song Composition contests will be conducted.
- 4. The deadline for the submission of entries will be on Wednesday, February 15, 2023, at 12:00nn. Attached is the guidelines and criteria for the above contest as the bases for choosing the best entry. Winners will receive medals and cash prizes.
- 5. The culmination activity will be held at Datu Binasing Elementary School, Pigcawayan on **Tuesday**, **February 28**, **2023**, **at 8:00** am.

a. All winners of the activities are advised to attend the culmination activity to personally receive the award, if possible, together with their coaches/advisers, school heads, HNS personnel, and school nurse.

b. The winners will be notified prior to the culmination day.



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- Moreover, as a gesture of support and participation in the month-long celebration, all schools division offices (SDO) are hereby enjoined to hang tarpaulin outside their respective office buildings and premises on or before February 1, 2023.
