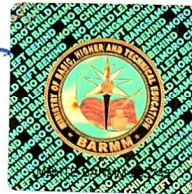

ACTIVITY PROPOSAL

Activity Title: Monitoring and Consultation of IPED Implementing Schools

1. Background and Rationale

The Bureau of Indigenous People's Education is the MBHTE response to the right of indigenous peoples (IP) to basic education that is responsive to their context, respects their identities, and promotes the value of their indigenous knowledge, skills, and other aspects of their cultural heritage. Specifically, the objectives of the IPED program are the following;

1. Make the curriculum culturally responsive to the specific community context of IP learners;
2. Build the capacity of Learners, school heads, and other concerned personnel at different levels of governance in implementing culture-based education for IPs;
3. Support the development of culturally appropriate learning resources and a learning environment responsive to the specific community context of IP learners;
4. Strengthen the policy environment support of IPED and;
5. Address the learning needs of IP learners who lack access to basic education

To strengthen the capacity of MBHTE in responding to IP learning needs, in a manner that is flexible, demand-driven, and evidence-based, the Bureau of Indigenous People's Education shall conduct BARMM-wide monitoring and evaluation of schools with IP learners.

1. Program/Activity Description

MBHTE's goal is that no Bangsamoro learner will be left behind and that is why it is doing its level best to bring every school aged-children to school by providing quality and authentic Education (R.A. 11054) this serves as the legal basis for reaching every learner in the BARMM regardless of race and preference to be included in the education program not only to be educated but to enable every learner to understand the essence of life.

The region shall conduct regular monitoring of program implementation in the school divisions as part of their mandated functions and responsibilities



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III. Objectives:

To ensure effective and efficient implementation of IPED in the different divisions, a Monitoring team managed by the Bureau of Indigenous Peoples Education shall be conducted annually, this serves as the venue for the divisions to report progress on their program implementation.

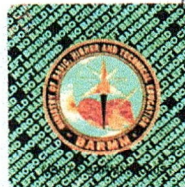
