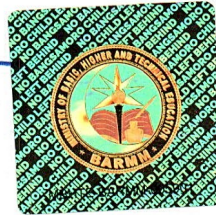

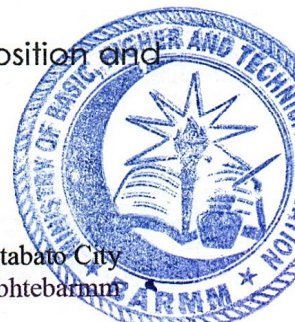

SUBJECT : **CREATION OF THE TASK FORCE FOR THE VERIFICATION OF EDUCATION DATA AND THE VALIDATION OF ALL DEVELOPMENT INTERVENTIONS RELATED TO EDUCATION**

DATE : 17 SHABAN 1444 H / 9 MARCH 2023

1. The Ministry, through its 12-point priority agenda, envisions an educational system in the region which prioritizes the learners' growth and development, features highly motivated and competent teachers and education managers, utilizes relevant and adaptive curriculum, provides safe and adequate learning spaces, and forges strong partnership within the education community.
2. Anchored on the vision of the 12-point priority agenda of the Ministry, the Ministry undertakes this initiative of verification and validation to identify opportunities for improvement, to stimulate collaborative action with the stakeholders in the field, and to transform these opportunities to responsive and effective educational interventions.
3. Preliminary assessment of the current state of affairs yielded the need to fortify data collection with regards to completeness, accuracy, reliability, and relevance; hence, the need for verification. Moreover, the changes in the education landscape brought primarily by the COVID-19 pandemic and the implementation of various education policies necessitated the validation of all education-related interventions to determine how these interventions are operationalized and how they are currently faring.
4. Moving forward, the operational issues, problems, and concerns which will be further identified as a result of this verification and validation shall be docketed among those requiring immediate attention and support from the Ministry.
5. In view of this, a **Task Force** (TF) shall be created with the following composition and responsibilities:

The **TF** shall be responsible for the following:

- a. Conduct validation of personnel in the Schools Divisions and schools in particular;
  - b. Issue identification cards based on validated and verified data;
  - c. Conduct an ocular inspection to check the state of school buildings and learning facilities, equipment, and supplies such as armchairs, teacher's boards, classrooms, and the like;
  - d. Validate learners' data and conduct assessment thereof;
  - e. Analyze collected and validated data and submit recommendation; and
  - f. Provide regular updates to the Office of the Minister.
6. The pilot implementation of this initiative shall be with the Schools Division pertaining to the Special Geographic Area (SGA).
  7. For immediate dissemination, guidance, and strict compliance.
