The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education and the USAID with its project ABC+: Advancing Basic Education in the Philippines work to attain our shared goal and commitment to improve the quality education in BARMM, in line with MBHTE's advocacy that "No Bangsamoro Child Shall be Left Behind."

- The ABC+ project's support to MBHTE is focused on the development of high-quality learning materials in Magindanawn language for Kinder to Grade 3 (K-3) learners as well as on training teachers on the use of these materials. We remain committed in our efforts to support MBHTE in providing strategies and interventions to provide access to quality and contextappropriate learning materials to early grade learners.
- USAID ABC+ Project has launched a new initiative, the MBHTE-Beginning Reading Program (BRP). This is a technology-based learning program that will use tablets or devices to deliver reading instruction to K-3 children who are struggling to read in the ABC+ implementing areas. The package will contain Early Grade Reading Materials (EGRMs) in various mother tongues including video-based beginning reading instructional modules that will be contextualized to BARMM and the Magindanawn mother tongue.
- Based on DepEd's experience and recommendations, an additional step after the quality assurance process is required prior to the development of EGRMs and before the filming of the videos. A final review is required to ensure that the agreements from the Quality Assurance process were correctly copied into the pre-production template.
