**ONLINE ESSAY WRITING CONTEST**

**A. Objectives:**

The purpose of this activity is to encourage the participation of BARMM employees and foster Bangsamoro nationalism in them. Through the essay competition, they are prompted to reflect on their personal contribution to the Bangsamoro.

**B. Mechanics:**

1. The ESSAY WRITING CONTEST is open to all BARMM Regional employees.
2. Only one essay entry is allowed per participant. In case it is found that a participant submitted more than 1 entry, all submitted entries by that participant will be considered invalid.
3. The entry must be original. Copied entries will not be considered under the contest. Any form of plagiarism will result in an automatic disqualification.
4. The entry must be in English or Filipino; minimum number of words is 800 and maximum of 3000 words. Entries with below 800 words are subject to disqualification.
5. All entries must be typed in a letter-size document and must be formatted as follows:
  - a. Font Size - 12
  - b. Font Style - Times New Roman
  - c. Justified
  - d. Double-Spaced, and
  - e. 1 inch margin on all four sides
6. The entry must revolve around the question, "How is my current work contributes to the Bangsamoro right to self-determination?".
7. All submitted entries shall be considered a property of the commission and may be used by the commission for publication and other legal purposes.
8. The entries should be submitted on or before March 8, 2023 through the link provided in the BCPCH official Facebook page. The essay must be uploaded with the title of the essay, participant's full name, contact number, and the agency he/she is connected to.

9. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries with non-compliance to the mentioned mechanics are considered disqualified.

10. All entries received are judged based on the same criteria and are judged by the jury selected by BCPCH. And here are the criteria for determining the winner:

a. Relevance to the Theme and Originality of Ideas	- 40%
b. Grammar and Correct Use of Words	- 20%
c. Organization of Ideas	- 20%
d. <u>Clarity in Language, Expression and Styles</u>	-20%
TOTAL	-100%

11. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

12. Winners will be announced on March 18, 2023.

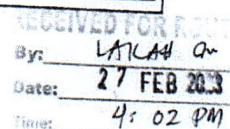
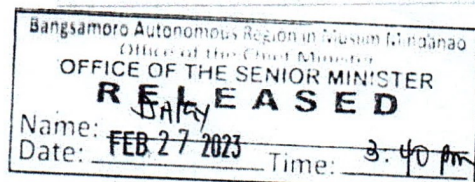
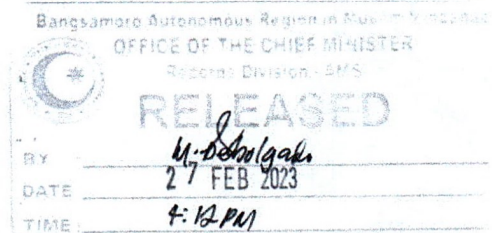
