1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through the Directorate General for Madaris Education (DGME), is in collaboration with the Australian Government through Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao (Pathways) and the Philippine National Research Center for Teacher Quality (RCTQ) on the project Learning Development (L&D) and Learning Resource (LR) Systems to Support Teacher Development in Madrasah Education. The project aims to design and trial systems to support the development of comprehensive, inclusive, and adaptive needs and standards-based Teacher Development plans, program interventions, and resources for Islamic Studies and Arabic Language (ISAL) and private madaris teachers.

PRIVATE MADARIS TEACHERS

February 7, 2023

- 2. Part of the project implementation is the conduct of a Needs Assessment which is one of the sub-systems in the L&D System for determining the learning and development needs of ISAL teachers and private madaris teachers. The results of the needs assessment are the bases for identifying, planning, designing, and implementing of L&D interventions.
- 3. In line with this, a needs assessment through a survey shall be conducted with the ISAL teachers, both from public and private madaris, and K-3 teachers from private madaris in all schools divisions from February to March 2023 (see Annex A for the list of public schools and private madaris participating in the needs assessment).

- 4. Each participating school shall be provided with a Needs Assessment Kit which contains the Guide for Principals/School Heads on the Administration of Needs Assessment Survey in Schools, Session Guides for the Orientation of Participating Teachers, Needs Assessment Questionnaires, Needs Assessment Answer Sheets, Consent Forms, and Monitoring and Receiving Form.
- 5. Principals/school heads shall administer the needs assessment survey in their respective schools and ensure that all participating teachers have accomplished and completed the survey (refer to the Administration Guidelines for Principals/School Heads provided in the Needs Assessment Kit).
- 6. The schools division offices, through the Madaris Division Supervisors, shall facilitate the conduct of a needs assessment by monitoring and ensuring the systematic administration of the needs assessment survey in schools.
- 7. The schools division superintendents shall ensure compliance of all participating schools in their respective divisions in conducting the needs assessment survey.
- The conduct of the needs assessment is scheduled for February-March 2023. Below
  is the needs assessment administration schedule covering the distribution of the
  needs assessment kits, survey accomplishment, and retrieval.
