CREATION OF THE MBHTE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE

DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT OF ISLAMIC STUDIES AND ARABIC

LANGUAGE (ISAL) CURRICULUM

DATE April 4, 2023

> 1. Pursuant to Chapter VIII, Section 27 of the Bangsamoro Administrative Code, one of the Specific Powers and Functions of Madaris Education is to develop appropriate curricula, quality textbooks, and teaching materials for Madaris Education that will establish an integrated system of education reflecting the ideals and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people.

- 2. In order to push reforms in the education system, particularly the curriculum and its delivery, the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) is hereby constituting a Technical Working Group (TWG) for the Design and Development of Islamic Studies and Arabic Language (ISAL) Curriculum through consultancy.
- 3. The roles and functions of the TWG are the following:
 - a. Overall monitoring and supervision of activities related to the fulfillment of the objectives of the project.
 - b. Execute the roles of the TWG as stated in the guidelines and policies and its Terms of Reference (TOR) for ISAL Curriculum Design and Development.
 - c. Direct coordination with the Service Provider to strengthen collaborations in the implementation of the provisions provided in the contract of agreement between the Service Provider and the MBHTE.
 - d. Recommends to the minister the approval of formulated policies and guidelines related to the curriculum as needed.
 - e. Attend meetings and related activities pertaining to the achievements of the objectives of the project.

4. All supplies, materials, food, transportation, equipment, and other financial requirements that may be needed by the TWG and service provider during joint meetings shall be included in the amount of the Contract of Agreement, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
