

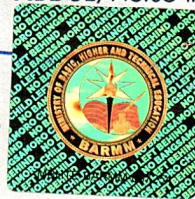

NOTICE OF MEETING: REPORTED SUICIDE CASES

1. This has reference to the received reports about the incidence of the suicide of two (2) learners from North Upi, Maguindanao II Division, Maguindanao del Norte last March and April 2023.
2. As part of the MBHTE's initial action, a caucus by and between MBHTE through the Bureau of Basic Education and the concerned School Heads and other Officials of Maguindanao II Division was held primarily to know the circumstances surrounding the occurrence of these cases. In the course of the discussion, it was agreed that collaborative efforts of the appropriate agencies and authorities should be sought for possible intervention in the identified schools and ensure proper action be held thereon.

In view of this, we earnestly seek your participation and involvement as we respectfully invite you to join us in an emergency meeting set for this coming Thursday, April 20, 2023, at 1:00 p.m., to be held at the Conference Room, Bangsamoro Planning and Development Authority (BPDA) Office. The meeting will explore ways in which we can support the affected individuals and prevent further occurrences of these cases.
