1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through its Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) under the Basic Education subsector, crafted the Bangsamoro Teachers' Professional and Moral Development (BTPMD) Standards that will serve as the framework in building the capacities of teachers to deliver contextualized in-service trainings for school administrators and education support personnel that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people.
2. The CID conducted a series of in-service trainings for the 11 schools divisions in BARMM. The recipient of this In-Set is from **Key Stage 1:** Kindergarten to Grade 3, **Key Stage 2:** Grades 4 to 6, **Key Stage 3:** Junior High School, and **Key Stage 4:** Senior High School teachers. Furthermore, this activity is in collaboration with the education partners such as University of the Philippines, DepEd-NEAP, Save the Children, UNICEF, Cirrolytix, Readability, and the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao. It is within this context that the CID shall conduct a **Training Reflection and Learning Session** on **May 8-12, 2023** at Samal Island, Davao City.
3. The activity is designed to broaden the knowledge, skills, and ability of the training management team through effective and comprehensive learning sessions that shall generate insights and learnings for program delivery improvements of the InService Training Program.
4. The participants are expected to arrive on May 8, check-in is at 2:00 p.m. and check-out is on May 12, at 12:00 noon. Kindly see Annex A for the list of participants.
