- 1. The Bangsamoro Education Code (BAA No. 18) embodies BARMM's commitment to inclusive, relevant, and quality education through establishing, maintaining, and supporting a complete and integrated education system in the region.
- 2. Through the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) Planning Division, the gains of the 1st Bangsamoro Development Plan (BDP 2020 – 2022) were analyzed, and enhancements were introduced as part of the development of the 2nd BDP (BDP 2023 - 2028).
- 3. To ensure an efficient and effective implementation of the programs, projects, and activities in the 2nd BDP, a Technical Working Group on Monitoring and Evaluation was constituted through Regional Memorandum No. 861, s. 2022.
- 4. A series of capacity development activities on Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBME) was conducted from March – December 2023, through OIDCI with support from Pathways.
- 5. As a follow-through, a workshop on the "Development of Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation Tool for MBHTE" will be conducted on May 17-21, 2023 (inclusive of travel time) in Zamboanga City.
- 6. The main objective of this activity is the development of monitoring and evaluation tools for common strategies and understanding of M&E. The MBHTE-PD will facilitate the process, together with the subsectors and program holders.
