- 1. Article IX Section 16 of the Republic Act 11054 known as the Bangsamoro Organic Law states that the Bangsamoro Government shall establish an education framework that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people. Specifically, peace education is particularly mentioned in the said law.
- 2. In this relation, the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) has started developing a peace education working framework as the basis for the integration of peace education into the learning areas across grade levels and learning areas in the basic education.
- 3. Further, the Ministry shall hold a consultative planning workshop for the integration of Bangsamoro History and Peace Education in the Grade 1-6 curriculum in MBHTE-BARMM. This activity is in partnership with the Kadtuntaya Foundation Incorporated (KFI). This activity shall have the following objectives:
 - a. Identify the current needs and gaps in making the curriculum relevant to the context of the Bangsamoro
 - b. Set the direction for Peace Education, Bangsamoro history, identity, and culture in relation to the current working peace education framework
 - c. Identify themes and learning areas where Peace Education, Bangsamoro history, identity, and culture can be incorporated into the Curriculum
 - d. Review existing KFI existing modules and materials on peace education
 - e. Outline immediate next steps and plans
