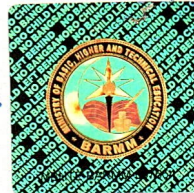

SUBJECT : **PEACE EDUCATION AND CONFLICT SENSITIVE TRAINING WORKSHOP WITH YOUTH LEADERS, MADARIS TEACHERS, AND SCHOOL TEACHERS IN THE BARM**

DATE : May 12, 2023

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education, through the Directorate General for Madaris Education (DGME) with support from the Consortium of Bangsamoro Civil Society (CBCS), Inc. and European Delegation in the Philippines (EU), will conduct a **Peace Education and Conflict Sensitive Training Workshop with Youth Leaders, Madaris Teachers and School Teachers in the BARM** on May 15-16 in Cotabato City and May 18-19, 2023 in Zamboanga City.
2. This activity aims to enhance the understanding of Youth Leaders, Madaris Teachers, and School Teachers on the root causes of Violent Extremism, its signs, and its impact on peace, security, and development.
3. In line with this, eight (8) ISAL Teachers-Asaatidz are requested to participate in the May 15-16 training. Specifically, they should be from Maguindanao I, Maguindanao II, Cotabato City, and Special Geographic Area divisions.
4. Meanwhile, 10 ISAL Teachers-Asaatidz coming from island divisions of Basilan, Lamitan City, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi shall participate on May 18-19, 2023 training.
5. All activity-related expenses such as food, hotel accommodation, and transportation shall be charged to the CBCS.
