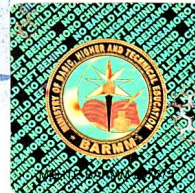

SUBJECT : **COMPREHENSIVE RAPID LITERACY ASSESSMENT (CRLA) BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR (BoSY) DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP**

DATE : May 18, 2023

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE) and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) with its project ABC+: Advancing Basic Education in the Philippines are working together to attain their shared goal and commitment to improve the quality education in BARMM.
2. To gain a better understanding of the current literacy level of learners in the BARMM, MBHTE in partnership with ABC+, shall conduct the CRLA Development Workshop. The CRLA or the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment is a set of diagnostic assessments that informs the teacher of each learners' reading profile.
3. The activity aims to develop this assessment in the languages of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao to include: Yakan, Bahasa Sug and Meranaw and their respective variations, which shall be used as baseline for the MBHTE's reading program.
4. This activity is on May 22 to 26, 2023 in Davao City (final venue to be announced prior to the arrival). Board and lodging and travel expenses shall be shouldered by ABC+ based on its financial policies and procedures. Only the use of public transportation is allowable and receipts/tickets are required for submission; fees for hired private service vehicles are not allowed for reimbursement.
5. First meal is breakfast on May 22 (Monday) while last meal is breakfast on May 27 (Saturday) except participants coming from Sulu and Basilan who will be provided with accommodation and meals starting May 21, 2023.

DATE : May 10, 2023

In line with the efforts of the Department of Education to provide solutions to the perennial problem with literacy faced by the country, the Bureau of Curriculum Development in partnership with ABC+, shall conduct the **CRLA Development Workshop**. The activity aims to develop assessment tools for 10 mother languages and their respective variations, which shall serve as pre-assessment for the Learning Camp Reading Program. The activity shall be conducted via two parallel workshops on **May 22 to 26, 2023: the Luzon cluster shall be held in a venue in Cabanatuan City; and the Mindanao cluster shall be held in a venue in Zamboanga City.**

In line with this, DepEd Personnel who teach K-3 in the following languages shall serve as test item developers during the workshop. We request that the Regional and Division Offices prioritize those who have served as part of the Mother Tongue Primer Development Team.
