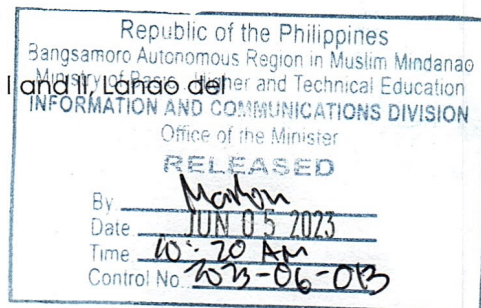
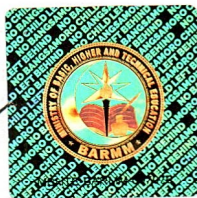

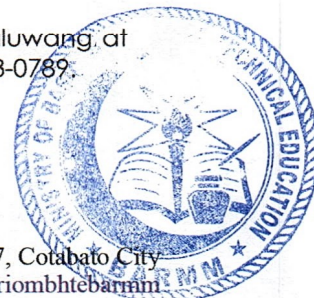

SUBJECT : **VALIDATION OF PROFILED SCHOOL-LESS BARANGAYS' ADM-AKAP LEARNING CENTERS IN MAGUINDANAO I AND II, LANAO DEL SUR I AND II, SULU, AND TAWI-TAWI**

DATE : June 1, 2023



1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through its Directorate General of Basic Education (DGBE), initiated the implementation of the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) – Abot Kaalaman sa Pamilyang Bangsamoro Program (AKAP) in Bangsamoro Autonomous in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) which aimed to give education access to all Bangsamoro children who live in geographically isolated, disadvantaged, and conflict-affected areas (GIDCA).
2. In support of this program, the Regional Technical Working Group (TWG) for education access and Consortium of Bangsamoro Civil Society Inc. (CBCS) will conduct a **Validation of Profiled School-less Barangays' ADM-AKAP Learning Centers in Maguindanao I and II, Lanao del Sur I and II, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi on June 5-16, 2023** (simultaneously). The activity aims to improve the quality, effectiveness, and management of the program.
3. Participants in this activity are the members of the Regional TWG for Education Access, ADM Division Coordinators, selected MLGUs, BLGUs, Barangay Chairmen, and possible school heads of the Catchments School targeted. The Division ADM Coordinators shall coordinate with the BLGU and MLGU on the above-mentioned name activity.
4. Travel expenses, food, accommodation, and per diem of the participants shall be charged to the CBCS funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
