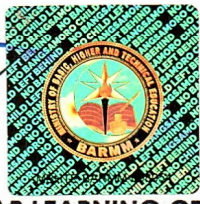

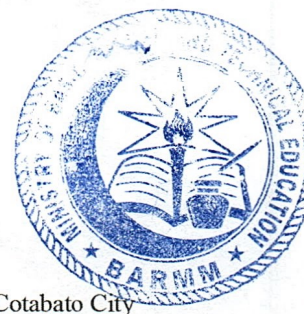

SUBJECT : **MONITORING OF ADM-AKAP LEARNING CENTERS IN THE SCHOOL-LESS BARANGAYS AND CONDUCT OF LEARNERS CONTENT-BASED ASSESSMENT TO AKAP LEARNERS**

DATE : May 16, 2023

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) flagship program on education access, **Abot-Kaalaman sa Pamilyang (AKAP) Bangsamoro Program**, is continuously engaging with its partners in ensuring the delivery of accessible and quality education to the Bangsamoro learners.
2. To ensure that AKAP learners are receiving quality learning and instruction, the regional and division Technical Working Group (TWG) on Education Access, in coordination with the AKAP catchment school heads, with support from BRAC Philippines will conduct a **learning assessment of the AKAP learners through the K-2 Learners Content-Based Assessment (LCBA)** which is aligned with the competencies of Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELC).
3. The assessment aims to generate opportunities and determine the extent of learning among the AKAP K-2 learners across the eight (8) schools divisions in BARMM, particularly Maguindanao I and II, Lanao del Sur I and II, Basilan, Lamitan City, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.
4. Schedules for each division are as follows:
 - Sulu Division: May 22-26, 2023
 - Basilan and Lamitan Divisions: May 29-June 2, 2023





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- Lanao del Sur 1 Divisions: June 4-6, 2023
 - Lanao del Sur 2 Divisions: June 7-10, 2023
 - Tawi-Tawi Division: June 12-16, 2023
 - Maguindanao 1 Division: June 19-23, 2023
 - Maguindanao 2 Division: June 26-30, 2023
