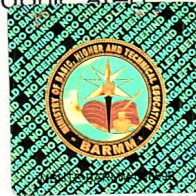

SUBJECT : **EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS FOR SGA SCHOOLS DIVISION 2**  
 DATE : 24 JULY 2023

1. As enshrined in the Bangsamoro Education Code, the Ministry shall provide an educational framework that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people which shall conform to the minimum standards set by the National Government. True to its mandate, the Ministry ensures the delivery of responsive education programs and projects for all.
2. The Ministry recognizes the absence of Local Government Units (Provinces and Municipalities) in the 63 barangays comprising the SGA. Corollary thereto is the non-existence of Local School Boards which are mandated to determine the annual supplementary budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the province or municipality that shall be reflected in the form of annual school board budget (Special Education Fund).
3. Under the Bangsamoro Education Code and its Implementing Rules, the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall supervise the operations of all public and private elementary, secondary and integrated schools, and learning centers.
4. Despite the absence of LSBs for SGA, the Ministry shall be addressing the needs in schools and shall be providing programs and projects.
5. The SDO for SGA is hereby directed to conduct an immediate assessment of the school-needs in the SGA and submit a written report to the Office of the Minister.
6. All concerns of the SDO on school operations and needs, the same must be reported and submitted to the MBHTE Office of the Minister.
