- 1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) Directorate General for Basic Education (DGBE), crafted the Bangsamoro Teachers' Professional and Moral Development (BTPMD) Standards. The BTPMD standards are contextualized version of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) that considered the need to "institutionalize an education framework that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people" (Sec. 16 Art. 9 RA11054). The BTPMD was designed to equip teachers with skills, knowledge, attitudes, and values that will improve the delivery pf relevant content considering the needs of all types of learners.
- 2. Guided by the BTPMD standards, the MBHTE DGBE, through the Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) in partnership with Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao Program, Readability Center, and the University of the Philippines System, has designed the In-Service Training Program to equip teachers with skills, knowledge, attitudes, and values that will improve the delivery of relevant content considering the needs of all types of 21st-century learners in Bangsamoro.
- 3. With this, a Refresher Course for Key Stage 1 Division Trainers and INSET Rollout Planning Workshop shall be conducted on July 23-27, 2023 (inclusive of travel days) in Davao City (specific venue shall be communicated directly to the participants).
- 4. During the three-day activity, the participants are expected to:
 - review and refresh the contents of the K-3 In-service Trainers Training;
 - understand and formulate actions to implement the existing monitoring and evaluation plan and tools for the K-3 In-service implementation rollout and post-
 - clarify tasks, roles, and functions of the division-level training team members to the implementation rollout; and

- reach an agreement on the ways forward and developed the corresponding implementation plan.
