- 1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through the office of its Directorate General for Basic Education in cooperation with the Consortium of Bangsamoro Civil Society Inc. (CBCS), is closely working together in ensuring the delivery of quality and accessible education to all school-aged children in the school-less barangays of BARMM.
- 2. The CBCS has already implemented Phase 4 of KAPED KA CSO SA AKAP Bangsamoro. As one of the local partners of the MBHTE, they continuously support the education ministry through their advocacy "it takes a village to raise a child" which is also in line with the "no Bangsamoro learner shall be left behind" campaign of the MBHTE. The civil society organizations (CSOs), as implementing partners, were given an opportunity to engage with multi-stakeholders in order to guarantee inclusive access to education for the school-aged children in the school-less barangays for the past two (2) years.
- 3. The major tasks assigned to the CSOs for this 4th Phase are to:
 - a. do community profiling and mapping of learners, and assess the readiness of school-less/unserved barangays;
 - b. mapping of potential learners from Kinder to Grade 3 in these 136 baranagys provided for by the MBHTE; and
 - c. engage barangay officials, parents, and catchment school heads in discussions to determine their readiness to engage in the AKAP BM Project.

- 4. The CBCS, together with the Regional TWG on Access, conducted the validation of the already profiled unserved barangays last June 2023.
- 5. In connection with this, the CBCS and its partners will hold a **two-day Project Review** on **August 7-8**, **2023** at Em Manor, Cotabato City. The activity aims to:
 - a. present the result of the Community Profiling and Validation, as well as the results of the monitoring activities in the current 106 Learning Centers;
 - b. discuss the score-carding tool;
 - c. discuss the School Improvement Plans of the Learning Centers; and
 - d. learn lessons from the implementation of the 4th Phase of KAPED KA CSO SA AKAP BM.
