By collecting and properly disposing recyclable materials like plastic, paper, and metal, individuals or communities can earn money through upcycling or transforming these materials into useful products.
- 3. The initiative provides opportunities for people to showcase their creativity and produce practical crafts that can be exhibited and utilized in homes, schools, parks, and more. The program targets various participants which include individuals, group/organizations, schools/universities, and barangays.
- 4. Please be guided by the following:

A. GUIDELINES

- a. Eligible Materials The participants shall only use recyclable plastic materials to make creative projects, such as furniture, table, fence, decoration, art crafts, etc.
- Participants The competition is open to the provinces of Maguindanao del Sur and Maguindanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.
- c. Drop-Off Center The participants shall drop off the finished products with their entry form at the nearest MENRE Office (PENREO, CENREO, or Regional Office via the Environment Management Services).

20%	Functionality and Sustainability	The product must be well- made, useful, and can last long.	
20%	Beautification and Location	The product should be well-made, beautiful, located within the school territory and can be used by the students.	
20%	Quality and Durability	The product must be of good quality, durable, and able to resist repeated use.


