CONSULTATION AND ASSEMBLY FOR FEEDBACK AND EVALUATION OF

PILOT TESTED CO-DEVELOPED **BANGSAMORO** PARLIAMENTARIAN PROGRAM THROUGH THE CONTEXTUALIZED INQUIRIES, INVESTIGATIONS, AND IMMERSION CURRICULUM FOR

SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN BARMM

DATE August 10, 2023

- 1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher, and Technical Education (MBHTE), in collaboration with the Legal Network for Truthful Elections (LENTE), previously conducted two (2) consecutive trainings with 32 senior high school (SHS) teachers, coordinators, and heads, from the 11 schools division offices (SDOs) in BARMM.
- 2. The first training session was the Training Workshop and Writeshop with BARMM Educators and Writers, which took place last October 3–8, 2022, at the Apple Tree Resort and Hotel in Opol, Misamis Oriental. Participants were able to collaborate on the modification of the curriculum and creation of instructional materials for SHS students with the assistance of administrators from the MBHTE and LENTE. These instructional materials contained discussions about the parliamentary system in the context of the Bangsamoro and the history that led to it.
- An additional training session for teachers was held following the completion and finalization of the jointly developed instructional materials. It took place last February 3-5, 2023, at Ever-O Business Hotel in Zamboanga City, and it was designed to support the pilot testing of the delivery of the instructional materials for SHS in BARMM. The project's ultimate objective is to make this significant topic a part of the BARMM educational system at all levels.
- 4. Last April and May 2023, the MBHTE and LENTE conducted a monitoring on the classroom delivery of the above-mentioned instructional materials and the implementation of the Bangsamoro Junior Parliamentarian Program in six (6) of the select schools namely: (1) Tairan National High School in Basilan last April 17-18, (2)

Marawi City National High School in Marawi City last April 24-25, (3) Olandang National High School in SGA last May 23, (4) Parang National High School in Maguindanao del Norte last June 1, (5) Mohammad Qabael National High School in Lanao Del Sur I last June 6, and (6) Cotabato City National High School Main Campus last April 26 and May 24-25.

- 5. In accordance with the project's objectives, the MBHTE and LENTE will be conducting a Feedback and Evaluation of the Pilot Tested Co-developed Instructional Materials for Senior High School Students. It is intended to assess the co-developed instructional materials and their delivery in the 11 selected classes of each select school from the SDOs in BARMM. This also aims to address the unforeseen gaps and challenges that arose in the implementation duration of the pilot testing phase. There will be two cumulative activities in relation to the feedback and evaluation:
 - a. Visit to the Schools Division Superintendents on August 14-17, 2023 at their respective SDOs in Cotabato City, Lanao del Sur I, Lanao del Sur II, Maguindanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, Marawi City, and SGA; meanwhile, Schools Divisions Superintendents of Basilan, Lamitan City, Sulu will be gathered on August 14, 2023, in Zamboanga City, and the visit for the Schools Division Superintendent of Tawi-Tawi will be on August 15, 2023, at their respective SDO.
 - b. Assembly of Teachers and Implementers on August 22 to 25, 2023 at Zamboanga City.
- 6. The assembly will be composed of feedback and evaluation on the following subject matters:
 - a. The Historical Context of BARMM
 - b. The Bangsamoro Organic Law
 - c. The Parliamentary System of BARMM
 - d. Implementation of Action Research and the Bangsamoro Junior Parliamentarian Program (Immersion)
 - e. Consultation on the Transformation of Student Governing Council to adopt the Parliamentary System of Student Council
- The culmination of the assembly will be the second phase of the pilot testing of the curriculum guide and instructional materials in all SHS strands of the select schools within the 11 SDOs in BARMM.
- 8. In light of this, all Schools Division Superintendents are hereby directed to send three (3) representatives from each division to participate in the training. The representatives shall be the same participants who were able to join the pilot testing phase of the co-developed instructional materials.
