1. Monitoring is seeing if you are doing what you said you would do and done in a systematic approach to overseeing planning, learning, and teaching. This is part of the evaluation that ensures that information is gathered so that judgments can be made and questions answered accordingly.

- Schools division monitoring and evaluation (M&E) help in providing a consolidated source of information showing the progress of the schools, offices, and programs they supervise. An M&E gives a basis for both questioning and testing assumptions. M&E should be an integral component of any school and office since it helps in planning and adjustment. It shows the mistakes and creates paths for both learning and improving.
- 3. In line with this, the M&E Section of the Directorate General for Basic Education (DGBE) will conduct a series of Field Monitoring Visits to monitor programs, projects, and activities of the schools division offices (SDOs) and schools. This is to determine their level of performance implementation milestone and document best practices for possible replication region-wide. Also, to identify gaps and challenges in the implementation cycle which will then be the bases of the DGBE for policy direction, strategic planning, and resource allocation.
- 4. The schedules of the visits and deployment of appropriate tools to be used will be communicated to the SDOs through the M&E Officers as soon as all logistical arrangement has been completed.
- Meanwhile, all SDOs should prepare their accomplishment reports based on the DMERA Template with all its means of verification and other attachments.
