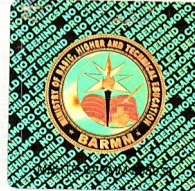

1. This has reference to the issued MBHTE Regional Memorandum No. 420, s. 2023 dated June 6, 2023, regarding the **updates to the MBHTE Regional Memorandum No. 259. S, 2023**, where the Australian Government, through the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao in collaboration with the Philippine Normal University (PNU) - Research Center for Teacher Quality (RCTQ) and the MBHTE, will be conducting a **Teaching and Resource Materials Package for Accredited Madrasah on August 28-September 2, 2023** at Blue Lotus, Davao City.
