RATIONALE:

The project aims to complement with the government effort to significantly contribute to the Covid-19 vaccination coverage through the augmentation of human resource of the Integrated Provincial Health Office (IPHO) of Maguindanao (IPHO Maguindanao) to reach the poorest, isolated, high level conflict areas and disadvantage communities in providing accessible vaccination sites to these areas. These include high-volume areas such as schools, government offices, malls and the like. Ensuring vaccination is convenient and readily accessible to the general population. USAID ReachHealth/ RTI International is partnering with Mindanao Organization for Social and Economic Progress (MOSEP) to localize the intervention and approach.

To guarantee herd immunity to the community, MOSEP has been working with various stakeholders in Maguindanao del Norte and Maguindanao del Sur adopting a whole-of-government approach through collaborative partnerships to ensure effective and efficient delivery of Covid-19 vaccination integrated with the routine immunization program.

OBJECTIVES:

- Identify interventions or factors that contributed to attainment of targets in the implementation of the COVID-19 vaccination in the 13 target municipalities in Maguindanao del Norte and Maguindanao del Sur.
